



# ***RECREATIONAL VEHICLES IN THE FLOODPLAIN***

**RECREATIONAL VEHICLE (RV)** is a vehicle used as temporary living quarters for recreational camping, travel or seasonal use. A RV has its own power or is mounted on or towed by another vehicle. This definition includes vehicles such as travel trailers, camping trailers, truck campers and motor homes. [KCC 14.04.045\(1\)\(a\)](#)

## **RVs IN THE FLOODPLAIN SHALL:**

- ◆ Be fully licensed and ready for highway use
- ◆ Be on its wheels or jacking system
- ◆ Use only quick disconnect type utilities and security devices
- ◆ Have no permanently attached additions
- ◆ Have no obstructions that prevent immediate movement [KCC 14.08.295\(2\)](#)



## **RVs SHALL NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN THE FLOODPLAIN FROM NOVEMBER 15TH UNTIL THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE MEMORIAL DAY!**

A RV is considered to be unattended after a Notice of Correction is placed on the RV and is observed there 72 hours later. Except in legally established campgrounds and RV parks. [KCC 14.08.295\(1\)](#)

Park model trailers are not allowed within the floodplain. [KCC 14.08.295\(3\)](#)
