At approximately 4:00 p.m. **CHAIRMAN GOLLADAY** opened the continued public hearing to consider amendments to Kittitas County Code Chapter 5, Temporary Seasonal Business License.

**DAVID TAYLOR, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DIRECTOR**, mentioned the proposed changes suggested by the Board of Commissioners during a recent study session, including renaming the process from "business" to "activities", and the fees at a rate of \$5.00/day or \$100.00/year. **THERE BEING NO PUBLIC IN ATTENDANCE TO TESTIFY, THE PUBLIC PORTION OF THE HEARING WAS CLOSED.**

**COMMISSIONER COE** thanked Mr. Taylor for his work, and said even though the language began broad, it had been tailored down. **COMMISSIONER GOLLADAY** felt there would be no benefit by sending it to the Planning Commission.


