CDS Staffing

Further discussion took place on the staffing issue including position versus pay grade, Budget position versus pay grade, the establishment of ranges blindly (look where they fit after they are established), and looking at internal comparisons first and outside comparisons second.

David Taylor updated the Board on the Shorelines issues.

WSAC Follow up

David Taylor reported on the following issues from the WSAC conference: Surface Water quality standards, Watershed Implementation, Salmon Recovery, and \$2.5 for screening in the Manastash. The Board directed him to research the Salmon Recovery on the internet.

Watershed Planning

Taylor said that on July 8 he would be asking for a public hearing to be held on August 5, 2003. He recounted the background and the purpose from start to present. He compared the advisory versus regulatory document. He said that HB 2514 would impact exempt wells and down stream flows.

BOCC Questions and concerns

Taylor informed the Board of a possible LUPA appeal.

The Board asked about the Fire Wise program. They wondered what's been adopted, How do citizen's deal with compliance with Firewise and How to get people to volunteer.
