Darryl Piercy, Director of Community Development Services gave a staff report on the Kittitas Foothills Preliminary Plat (P-06-12). He said an application was received from Mark Kirkpatrick, authorized agent for Kittitas Foothills LLC, landowner, for a 12-lot plat on approximately 35.69 acres, ranging in size from 3.02 to 4.35 acres each. The property is zoned Ag-3 and the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Designation is Rural. The property is located East of Cle Elum and South of SR 970 off of Leo Lane, Cle Elum, Washington (Tax Parcel Number 20-17-32000-0001). He reported the Planning Commission held a public hearing and voted to forward a recommendation of approval with a 5-0 vote.

Commissioner Huston asked if the Planning Commission reviewed the letter from Cathy Bambrick, Kittitas County Environmental Health Manager, outlining the process and the other one by Holly Duncan who said she

could not approve a Class B well system. He said there was no indication in the record that the statements were reconciled.

Mr. Piercy said the information had been provided to the Planning Commission, and felt the issue was probably rectified on a staff level. He explained there were conditions placed under the SEPA review relating to all the improvements including having to comply with the County Road Standards that would need to be met, which was also a consistent condition with the following two closed record meeting. He felt the conditions of SEPA were very clear.

Commissioner Huston moved to direct staff to prepare enabling documents approving the Kittitas Foothills Preliminary Plat (P-06-12), to be on the November 7, 2006 Commissioner Agenda. Chairman Bowen seconded.

Commissioner Huston expressed concern of comments coming in at the Planning Commission level from staff, recognizing there is room for that, but wanted to encourage staff to have everything clear before it gets to the public comment period during at the Planning Commission level, and if there are issues that come up, to make sure they are cited.

Motion carried 2-0.

The property is zoned Ag-3 and the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Designation is Rural. The Planning Commission held a public hearing and voted 5-0 to forward a recommendation of approval.

Commissioner Huston moved to direct staff to prepare enabling documents approving the Cle Elum Properties (P-06-15), to be on the November 7, 2006 Commissioner Agenda. Chairman Bowen seconded.

Commissioner Huston said his remarks made during the Kittitas Foothills Closed Record Meeting were to be included within this item. He suggested to staff that they make sure all information is in place prior to scheduling it before the Planning Commission, while recognizing it may slow things down a little bit on more of the complicated subject. He said if that makes people upset, they need to contact the Commissioners. Mr. Piercy explained steps have been taken internally to assist and staff is trying to an adequate analysis under SEPA.

Darryl Piercy, Director of Community Development Services, reviewed the Hidden Valley Estates Preliminary Plat (P-06-19). He said an application was received from Mark Kirkpatrick, authorized agent for Hidden Valley Estates, LLC, landowner, for a 10-lot Plat on approximately 33.37 acres, ranging in size from 3.02 to 3.87 acres each. The property is located East of Cle Elum and South of SR 970 off of Leo Lane, Cle Elum, Washington (Tax Parcel Number 20-17-32000-0028).
