WHITE SHORT PLAT (SP-06-63)

At approximately 1:30 p.m. **CHAIRMAN CRANKOVICH** opened a hearing to consider an appeal of an Administrative Decision of the Conditional Preliminary Approval of the White Short Plat (SP-06-63). An application filed by Michael White for a short subdivision of a 4-lot Short Plat on approximately 38.45 acres of land zoned Ag-3, Location: North of Upper Peoh Point Road, South of Lower Peoh Point Road, East of Iron Mountain Road, Cle Elum, Washington, (Tax Parcel Number 19-15-01000-0042, 0002). He indicated that staff received a letter dated December 20, 2006 from Chris Cruse, Authorized Agent requesting to withdraw his appeal of the conditions of preliminary approval for the White Short Plat (SP-06-65), noting that the applicant agrees to meet the conditions as outlined in the November 1, 2006 letter from Kittitas County CDS Department. **CHAIRMAN CRANKOVICH** indicated that the Board was pleased to see Mr. Cruse's letter when it came in, and noted that they Board was supportive of the continued efforts of Mr. Cruse and the County Community Development Services Department.

COMMISSIONER HUSTON moved to withdraw the Appeal as requested in the letter dated December 20, 2006 from Chris Cruse of Cruse & Associates. **COMMISSIONER CRANKOVICH** seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
