STUDY SESSION MINUTES

May 14, 2007

TRAP & SKEET CLUB UPDATE: Kelly Carlson (DPW) updated Commissioner Bowen on the status of the lead removal at the gun club site. She stated that the EBDA lot is clean and is anticipating a report from Fulcrum to support it. She stated that the Trap & Skeet Club is working with Fulcrum to come up with a solution that will work for everyone involved and not cost them a substantial amount of money.

FOWLER CREEK ROAD: Doug D'Hondt (DPW) stated that in a previous study session the BOCC directed staff to come to them when at any time this project would not or could not meet the county road standards. He stated that there is narrow right of way near the Burchak property and limited site distance. He stated that there is only 30' of right of way near the properties of Navarre and Adams. He also stated that a delineation of some type may need to be used near the intersection with Westside Road to confirm lane usage to traffic. Pat Deneen stated that he had submitted the SEPA for the removal of the site obstruction and once the 30-day waiting period is complete he should have the project done by July.

Board Direction: **Move forward with project as directed.**

MERRIL-RING/FOREST SERVICE: Chad Bala presented a draft agreement between the Forest Service and Merrill-Ring. He stated that this is close to the final agreement. Director Drexler stated that as soon as this document is signed, Public Works will complete their review.
