

Group “B” Water Systems Approval

Group “B” Water System defined:

- A water system serving 3-14 connections and serving any number of people for less than 60 days per year **OR**
- A water system serving 3-14 connections and serving less than 25 people for 60 days or more per year.

The following information must be submitted to Kittitas County Public Health Department to obtain approval of a Group “B” Water System that will serve 3-9 connections:

A well site inspection is required to be performed prior to actual drilling to ensure optimum location is selected. If there is an existing well, an inspection must be performed and the well site approved before final approval will be granted.

Water systems serving greater than 9 connections must be designed by a licensed Professional Engineer. **Group “B” water systems that will serve 10 to 14 connections must be approved by the Washington State Department of Health.**
