
Clay Myers, Undersheriff, reported there had been flooding being experienced in the Kittitas Valley beginning Saturday May 14, 2011, which resulted in the loss of power to residents, impacts to transportation and gas lines creating public health issues. He said the Emergency Operations Center had been activated this morning and they will be having a status meeting at 1:00 p.m. He indicated that the Red Cross is also on standby if needed. He recommended to the Board that they declare an emergency due to extensive flooding, resulting in extensive damages to County roads and bridges, private roads, homes, businesses and farmland in Kittitas County.

Commissioner Crankovich moved to approve Resolution No. 2011-048, Local Agency Declaration of Emergency. Commissioner O'Brien seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The Agenda Study Session was adjourned at 11:09 a.m.
