JAIL VIDEO RETENTION

COMMISSIONERS

At 1:50 p.m. Chairman Crankovich opened a Special Meeting to discuss video retention requirements for the Jail.


Jim Goeben, Information Technology Director explained how according to the Secretary of State the retention for jail video is 60 days and not 30 days so they need more storage. He asked the company who is working on the virtualization center how much it would be for additional storage to cover the entire network for the next five years, and it would be approximately \$36,000.00 which is a cost savings of 40% since they would be already working on the project. Steve Panattoni, Patrol Sergeant said they could pay \$5,000.00 of the cost from the 2010 Homeland Security grant.

There was discussion on whether to purchase or lease the equipment. Commissioner Jewell and Chairman Crankovich said they would rather purchase the equipment up front rather than lease it for approximately \$36,000.00 and \$5,000.00 of that to come from a grant obtained by the Sheriff's Department.
