Social media archive costs update

Mr. Goeben updated the Board:

- \$150/month for 20 social media accounts, with a 1,000 new record limit per month. Our current average is 63 records/month.
- Answer to the Board's questions in the 2/10/2014 IT Study Session:

- o Is the 1,000 record limit an average per month over the year?
- o Does unused record count roll-over month-to-month?
- o What happens when we exceed 1,000?


