Public records request statistics online

Mr. Goeben presented Commissioner O'Brien's request to post on the county website a running report of the hours spent (cost) on public disclosure requests and the top requesters. The IT Committee reviewed a summary of annual totals and feels the amount of time reported in the tracking system does not represent a significant burden to warrant posting. The Committee also feels naming requesters would appear punitive. Therefore the committee recommends not posting the information.

Board direction: Tabled until the May 12 IT Study Session when Commissioner O'Brien is present.

Software development

Mr. Goeben discussed with the Board the permit application software project. Phase 1 will be a requirements document. Mr. Goeben will form a committee consisting of members from each department issuing permits. The committee will draft the document to include technology and user requirements. It will be reviewed with the BOCC, after which public comment may be solicited.

NetSupport Notify audit

Mr. Goeben updated the board on the audit of NetSupport Notify deployment. It has been installed on all computers. A desktop update that provides better installation management will be applied when the vendor fixes a bug that causes the notification not to be displayed when the computer is locked.

Technology policy review

Mr. Goeben asked the board if it wished to postpone modifying Technology Policy 11 Websites until a new Event Center Director is hired.


Board direction: Hold the BOCC review of Technology Policies until an Event Center Director is hired and can comment on policy 11.

Other business


- The mayor of Ellensburg has appointed Mr. Goeben to the Utility Advisory Committee.
