

Law & Justice Study Session Minutes  
September 3, 2014

Meeting called to order at 0800 a.m.

**Present:**

Commissioner Jewell, Commissioner Gary Berndt, Commissioner Obie O'Brien, Undersheriff Clayton Myers, Command Paula Hocter, Maintenance/Solid Waste Director Patti Johnson.

Discussed replacing the Secure Lobby Door in the jail and Commissioner Berndt discussed the finances with Judy Pless and was advised this is the time to fix the door. The money will be coming out of the General Fund.

Commissioner Berndt discussed having a maintenance plan for the other doors in the facility to keep them working for the next ten years. Patti Johnson will be looking into a maintenance agreement with Southern Folgers.

Discussed the delay on the inverter/lights in the jail because it was ordered over 4 months ago and it hasn't been shipped yet. Patti Johnson will be following up with the company to find out why it has not shipped yet.

Patti Johnson advised the Commissioners that the AC unit on top of the jail will need to be replaced since it was the one that was removed from the court house in the 90's.

Patti is also going to provide the Commissioners with a list of maintenance items for the 2015 year so the Commissioners can see what needs to get done and what they can fund.

Elevator was discussed because it is not working properly and filled them on all of the issues. The doors don't close on the first floor, the speaker doesn't work, the floor needs repaired, and buttons in the control room don't work as they should. Patti will be working with the contractor to get everything fixed.

Commissioners suggested using K-mod for the female program room and we discussed the effects of losing 22 beds in the facility. The jail will work on another solution for a program room and will bring it back to the board.

Replacing the carpet in the booking room and control room Commissioner Berndt wants to think about a different solution and will revisit it at a later date.


Patti will be purchasing paint for the jail.
