PARKING ON COUNTY PROPERTY

At 2:02 p.m. **CHAIRMAN BERNDT** opened a Public Hearing to consider amending Kittitas County Code Chapter 10.06 - Parking on County Property.

COMMISSIONER O'BRIEN reviewed proposed amendments to the Kittitas County Code Chapter 10.06. He indicated the amount of residential development and parking around the Courthouse has begun to affect people coming in to conduct County business. He said the goal would allow a procedure to warn people that a permit is required for overnight parking. Overnight parking permits could be obtained from the Human Resource Department at no cost to the employee. He noted a request for proposals has not been sent out yet for the towing of vehicles. **CHAIRMAN BERNDT** said a Judge had expressed a few concerns how periodically there are people sentenced to jail at the time they are in Court and end up having to leave their car in the parking lots. **COMMISSIONER O'BRIEN** said the Judge could be issued a few parking permits to give out at that time. He noted there could also be a warning given if they were going to jail for a significant amount of time and they could arrange to contact someone to come and pick up their vehicle.

THERE BEING NO ONE IN ATTENDANCE REQUESTING TO TESTIFY, THE PUBLIC PORTION OF THE HEARING WAS CLOSED.


