Kittitas County Community Development Services (CDS) received your Conditional Use Permit application on April 9, 2024, for a 90-megawatt solar power production facility. Your application has been **determined complete** as of May 6, 2024.

Continued processing of your application will include, but is not limited to, the following actions:

1. Posting of the property by the applicant is required prior to a notice of application. CDS will provide instructions on adequate posting. Signage may be obtained at the Community Development Services offices during regular business hours. The signage will be available for pickup by May 15, 2024.
2. A Notice of Application will be published in the newspaper and sent to all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
3. Consideration of written comments from all adjoining property owners, governmental agencies, and interested persons.
4. Notification of a Public Hearing date.

You may pick up the “Land Use Action” sign at the CDS office during regular business hours. The sign is to be posted on-site and visible to the traveling public. Once posted, please return the signed affidavit of posting and include photos of the posted sign(s). The signage will be available by May 15, 2024. After this has been completed, the Notice of Application will be issued within 14 days.
