1. THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING A TOPCON GTS SERIES TCTAL STATION. THE CONTROLLING MONUMENTS AND PROPERTY CORNERS SHOWN HEREON WERE LOCATED, STAKED AND CHECKED ROM A CLOSED FIELD TRAVERSE IN EXCESS OF 1:10,000 LINEAR CLOSURE AFTER AZMUTH ADJUSTMENT.

2. A PUBLIC UTLITY EASEMENT 10 FEET IN WIDTH IS RESERVED AIONG ALL LOT LINES. THE 10 FOOT EASEMENT SHALL ABUT THE EXTERIOR PLAIT BOUNDARY AND SHALL BE DIVIDED 5 FEET ON EACH SIDE OF INTERIOR LOT LINES. SAID EASEMENT SHALL ALSO BE USED FOR IRRICATION.

3. PER ROW 17.10.140 LANDOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTIOLLING AND PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF NOXIOUS WEEDS ACCORDINGLY, THE KITTIAS COUNTY NOXIOUS WEED BOARD RECOMENDS IMMEDIATE RESEEDING OF AREAS DISTURBED BY DEVELOPMENT TO PRECLUDE THE PROLIFERATION OF NOXIOUS WEEDS.

4. FOR SECTION SUBDIVISION, SECTION AND QUARTER SECTION COPNER DOCUMENTATION, BASIS OF BEARINGS AND ADDITIONAL SURVEY INFORMATION, SEE BOOK 21 OF SURVEYS, PAGES 208–211 AND THE SURVEYS REFERENCED THEREON.

5. MAINTENANCE OF THE ACCESS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS WHO BENEFIT FROM ITS USE

8. AN APPROVED ACCESS PERMIT WILL BE REQUIRED FROM THE DIPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS PRIOR TO CREATING ANY NEW DRIVEWAY ACCESS OR PERFORMING WORK WITHIN THE COUNT' ROAD RIGHT OF WAY.

ANY FURTHER SUBDIVISION OR LOTS TO BE SERVED BY PROPOSED ACCESS MAY RESULT IN FURTHER ACCESS EQUIREMENTS. SEE KITITAS COUNTY ROAD STANDARDS.

B. KITITAS COUNTY RELIES ON ITS RECORD THAT A SUPPLY OF POTABLE WATER EXISTS. THE APPROVAL OF THIS DIVISION OF LAND INCLUDES NO GUARANTEE OR ASSURANCE THAT THERE IS A LEGAL RIGHT TO WITHDRAW GROUNDWATER WITHIN THE LAND DIVISION.

9 KITITAS COUNTY WILL NOT ACCEPT PRIVATE ROADS FOR MAINTEMANCE AS PUBLIC STREETS OR ROADS LINTIL SUCH STREETS OR ROADS ARE BROUGHT INTO CONFORMANCE WITH CUBERNT COUNTY ROAD STANDARDS. THS REQUIREMENT WILL INCLUDE THE HARD SUFFACE PANNIG OF ANY STREET OR ROAD SWFFACE ORGINALLY WITH GRAVEL.

10. ENTIRE PRIVATE ROAD SHALL BE INSPECTED AND CERTIFIED BY A CIVIL ENGINEER LICENSED IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON SPECIFYING THAT THE ROAD MEETS KITITIAS COUNTY ROAD STANDARDS AS ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 6, 2005, PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF A BULLDING PERMIT. ANY FUTURE SUBDIVISION OR LAND USE ACTION WILL BE REVIEWED UNDER THE MOST CURRENT ROAD STANDARDS.

II.
