Dear Teachers & Staff,

With the start of the 2013-2014 school year, it's time to distribute the "In Your Classroom" fact sheets. The Kittitas County Public Health Department (KCPHD) distributes these annually so that you have a quick reference regarding what your students are reporting from the Healthy Youth Survey. The fact sheet is from the most recent Healthy Youth Survey, conducted in October 2012*. The categories selected for the fact sheets are areas that can put students at academic risk. Research found that "the more health risks students had, the more likely it was that they were also at academic risk." The research also found that for every health risk addressed, students' academic success increased. **

Please review the attached "In Your Classroom" fact sheet; addressing even one risk factor in a student will increase the student's ability to learn.

In 2012, Kittitas County Public Health Department provided a variety of programs that address children's' health:

-Teens Against Tobacco Use (TATU)	-Hand washing education
-Tobacco retailer education	-Food handlers classes
-Children's Immunizations	-Access to Baby and Child Dentistry

Due to state budget cuts, KCPHD will no longer be providing tobacco related prevention programs. However, we will be working in partnership with Kittitas County Community Network & Coalition to support their substance abuse prevention education services to the youth of our county. KCPHD will continue to provide ABCD, Food Handlers and hand washing education.
