Thank you for contacting the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) and providing documentation regarding the above referenced project. Should additional information become available, our assessment may be revised.

Our statewide predictive model indicates that there is a high probability of encountering cultural resources within the proposed project area. However, as no new grading or clearing is proposed, DAHP is not requesting a cultural resources survey at this time. We do ask that you prepare an Inadvertent Discovery Plan (IDP) and prepare construction crews for the possibility of encountering archaeological material during ground disturbing activities.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on SE-24-00023 regarding the Thayer Riprap Site Soil Import project application. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) has reviewed the application and supporting documents on file. Our comments are regarding the project's impact on Fish and Wildlife Habitat Conservation Areas, such as priority habitats and species (PHS), particularly shrubsteppe habitat.

The project area contains shrubsteppe habitat and is mapped as Manastash Ridge Mule Deer Winter Range, Manastash Ridge Elk Winter Range, and Umtanum Bighorn Sheep Annual Range, all of which are designated Fish and Wildlife Habitat Conservation Areas under Kittitas County's Critical Areas Ordinance (Chapter 17A.04).

The covering of shrubsteppe habitat with topsoil will negatively impact wildlife and habitat. To ensure no net loss, we recommend avoiding and minimizing shrubsteppe impacts as much as possible by utilizing already disturbed areas on site to the maximum extent, thus limiting the amount of new disturbance.

Any new disturbance should provide compensatory mitigation consistent with WDFW's PHS guidelines, 1:1 if the shrubsteppe habitat will be restored after the topsoil is gone and the proposed project has concluded, or 2:1 if the habitat will not be restored. To further understand shrubsteppe impacts, potential for mitigation and restoration, WDFW requests a site visit with the applicant and the County. A mitigation, monitoring and restoration plan should be prepared in consultation with WDFW as a condition of approval.
