Description: Osprey Solar Farm (CU-14-00004 & SD-14-00002) is a proposed 13.6 acre

photovoltaic solar power generation facility. The project is proposed on a site that is zoned Agriculture 20. The proposal is classified under Kittitas County Code (KCC) 17.61.010(9) as a "major alternative energy facility" and as such is a conditional use in the Agriculture 20 zone (KCC 17.61.020[4]). - 2) No additional flood control structures may be constructed on the project parcel.
- Development shall be limited to the proposal as submitted; modifications or expansion of the development shall require additional environmental review.
