- RECLAMATION PLAN: Slopes not steeper than 1:1, disturbed areas seeded and fertilize (100% crested wheat grass), strippings will be stockpiled for replacement throughout quarry area
- GENERAL COMMENTS: Site was active on date of inspection. The site has been manage in a marvelous manor. The walls of the quarry have all been sloped and sediments from near by road cuts have been spread on the quarry floor. The site has been seeded and is presently covered by a desert like vegetation similar to the surrounding area.
- 1. INACCURACIES OF AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE OPERATOR'S ANNUAL REPORT:
 - a. This office does not have a copy of the SM-2 or SM-6 Forms for this site.
 - b. If the quarry is enlarged, slopes should be in accordance with the 1993 Reclamation Law (i.e. between 2:1 and 3:1). The present slopes are close to that now.
 - c. The quarry is presently slightly back sloped into the hill. This should be incorporated into the design of the project. Back sloping will hold run off which will catch sediments and retain moisture for vegetation and wildlife.

DEAR RODNEY JOHNSON:

At the October 13th, 1993 Board of Adjustment Hearing, the Board approved your application for a conditional use permit for Concrete and Asphalt Batch Plants at the North Umptanum Ridge site off of Highway 82. The following conditions were also attached to this approval:

CONDITION:

1. Compliance with all applicable local and state agency permitting processes before production of asphalt or concrete from the proposed batch plants begin.

There is a 30 day appeal period for this decision. Anyone may appeal the Board within this time period. If there is no appeal a conditional use permit will be issued on November November 11th, 1993. No work consisting of the nature of the conditional use may take place until this permit is issued. If the conditional use permit is appealed it will be remanded to the Kittitas County Superior Court for a decision.
