SEPA Application Comments

- Within the environmental section of the SEPA Checklist question 1e, the applicant listed
 quantities of 640 CY for cut and fill. The grading permit which the applicant obtained through
 Public Works lists different quantities on the initial permit and the plan set which was
 submitted. Please verify that the listed value is correct.
- Any grading over 100 cubic yards of material requires a grading permit. Any grading over 500 cubic yards of material will require engineered grading and storm water plans. See Kittitas County Code chapter 14.05.
- An access/address permit would be required prior to any building permit being issued.
- The proposed project is within the FEMA identified floodplain and the applicant has applied for a floodplain development permit. As required by KCC 14.08.315, compensatory storage will be required for fill placed within the floodplain.
